## *Christ, Messiah*

Immediately this name, Messiah took me to a song (imagine that)! If you've been on the network long enough, you've already figured out that songs move me.

Here are the lyrics to Jesus Messiah by Chris Tomlin

He became sin Who knew no sin  
That we might become His Righteousness  
He humbled himself and carried the cross  
Love so amazing Love so amazing

Jesus Messiah. Name above all names. Blessed Redeemer. Emmanuel. The rescue for sinners.  
The ransom from Heaven. Jesus Messiah. Lord of all.

His body the bread His blood the wine  
Broken and poured out all for love. The whole earth trembled  
And the veil was torn  
Love so amazing Love so amazing

All our hope is in You All our hope is in You All the glory to You, God  
The light of the world

What love the Messiah has lavished on us that we should become sons and daughters of God! In Genesis, God provided a ram after asking Abraham to sacrifice his long-awaited son. A

substitutionary sacrifice was provided that day, a ram caught in a thicket. In Leviticus, under the old covenant, animal sacrifices were continually offered as a sacrifice for sin. The prophet Isaiah foretold that the Messiah would bear our sin and heal our wounds. (Isaiah 53:4-6).

Then the MESSIAH came, bearing our sins in his own body on that tree, that old rugged cross, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds we are healed. Oh, what love, the love of Messiah, born to take away our sins. Now we can have eternal life and an inheritance with Him because God accepted our Messiah's death as a substitute. Doesn't that just want to make you shout! Well just shout! Hallelujah! He deserves it!

### ***Daily reflections as we consider our Messiah:***

- **Monday:** Read Luke 9: 18-20. Ask God to speak to you through this study this week. Ask God to speak to you from His Word. Read Luke 9:18-20 aloud and tell Jesus what your response is to who you say He is and what He as Messiah means to you.
- **Tuesday:** Read John 7:14. If someone were to ask you – Why do you believe Jesus is who He says He is? – what would you say? Ask Jesus to help you give an account and be ready to answer assuredly and with confidence who you say that He is.
- **Wednesday:** Read Luke 2:11. How could you share the wonder of Christ today? What stands out to you from this passage about the Messiah?
- **Thursday:** Read Matthew 23:10. What changes can you make in your life to become more focused on the Messiah? In prayer today, ask Jesus to search your heart so that your heart can become completely His.
- **Friday:** Read Mark 8:27-9:1. Has your view of who Jesus is changed over time? In your time of prayer today, ask Jesus to continually grow your view of who He is.

- pushed you out of the courtroom, out of the classroom, and for all practical purposes, out of our culture.
- become unthankful and full of ingratitude which has led to pride, arrogance and a demanding people.
- dived into the sin of idolatry where no affection is shameful, being affirmed by our culture rather than by You O God.

- become rebellious are morally and socially chaotic.

Ask the Spirit to search your heart and reveal any areas of unconfessed sin. Acknowledge these to the Lord and thank Him for His forgiveness.
