




Week 15: October 16 – October 22, 2022

This week as you read through chapter 29 of *The Battle Plan for Prayer* you will read that “extraordinary prayer can yield extraordinary results.” Imagine what might happen if God’s people, united in one accord, sought the Lord with hands lifted up all night long during these days of trouble. Chapter 30 covers our priority as believers to pray for the lost – those who haven’t put their faith in Jesus Christ and established a relationship with Him. Read with anticipation for how God is continually growing you in your prayer life. How can you share these truths with others so that they might grow?

This past week, my EE team hit the nearby college campus to do on-the-job training. One of my trainees is part of a group that has been prayer walking the campus for a year or so – praying for God to move and for a student-led revival. After praying many months, this team of prayer walkers decided to act. Back in April of this year they held an evangelistic worship night and invited the college students. They didn’t stop. They continue to prayer walk this campus every week, so it wasn’t surprising that on Friday, during OJT we met Ridge – already a believer who said “this year I can feel a difference on this campus.” We were able to testify to God’s faithfulness to answered prayer. We asked Ridge to join the prayer effort, asking God to send a student-led revival on this college. We also met Clement from Africa and Ethan and Bryce, all believers who were encouraged by our stopping to talk with them, invite them to our churches’ college ministry and church services, and pray for them. We were able to invite them to join the prayer effort for a student-led revival. And it wasn’t surprising that we met Brennan who prayed to receive Jesus Christ on Friday. This ground is ready for harvest because prayer has covered its territory.

Weekly Prayer Requests for Week 15: October 16 – October 22, 2022

ADORATION: praising God for who He is and what He has done.

O Lord, You cover Yourself in light as with garment;
You stretch out the heavens like a tent curtain
And lay the beams of Your upper chambers in the water.
You make the clouds Your chariot
And walk on the wings of the wind.
You make the winds Your messengers,
Flames of fire Your servants.
You set the earth on its foundations
So that it can never be moved.

Pause to express your thoughts of praise and worship.

CONFESSION: stating our sins and asking forgiveness!

Father, here we are to confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone. There are times when we have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We are truly sorry and we humbly repent for the sake of your Son Jesus Christ, have mercy on us and forgive us; that we may delight in your will, and walk in your ways, to the glory of your Name. Amen

Ask the Spirit to search your heart and reveal any areas of unconfessed sin. Acknowledge these to the Lord and thank Him for His forgiveness.

THANKSGIVING: thanking God for specific things that He has done.

Jesus, we give thanks that You expressed Your concern for the lost when You said, "What man among you, if he has a hundred sheep and loses one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the one that is lost until he finds it? And when he finds it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing. And when he comes into his house, he calls his friends and neighbors together and says to them, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost!' I tell you that, in the same way, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous people who need no repentance. There is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents." Thank you for pursuing us and redeeming us from our iniquity.

EE Praises:

- On September 29th in Memphis, TN, Don Snipes taught a Everyday Evangelism launch with 10 attendees from 4 different churches. 8 people heard the gospel during OJT and 4 of them made a profession of faith. Other people were approached and were prayed for and/or given a gospel tract. Pray that their hearts are drawn to faith in Jesus and that God does a work of grace in them. This launch was held at Mid-America Baptist Theological Seminary. Pray that God will open a door for 2 clinics a year to be held at

this location so that students will learn to share the Gospel with confidence. Pray that the churches that attended this launch will implement the ministry in their churches.

Pause to offer your own expressions of thanksgiving. In prayer this week, thank God for His provision in your life.

SUPPLICATION: asking God for our needs and our wants.

Help us to consecrate ourselves and be holy before You, because You are the Lord our God. Help us to keep Your statutes and practice them, for You are the Lord who sanctifies us. O Lord, God of our fathers Abraham, Isaac and Israel, keep this desire in the hearts of Your people forever, keep our hearts loyal to You. Help us to examine all things, hold fast to the god, and abstain from every form of evil. If I begin to think that I am somebody when I am nobody, I am fooling myself. If ever I boast, let my boasting be in You, Lord.

- Pray continuously for individuals and families that have been impacted by the wide path of destruction and pain caused by Hurricane Ian. Many homes were reduced to rubble and many survivors have lost everything they've worked for. Pray for those that have lost friends and family members and pray for the rapid response teams that are the ground. Pray safety and protection for the teams. Pray for open doors for relief teams like the Billy Graham Rapid Response Teams and other faith-based teams to share the Gospel message and that many will come to faith in Jesus Christ.
- Pray that God would open the eyes of believers with hearts of love and compassion for the lost.
- Pray that God would unite local pastors in prayer for one another and for revival and restoration in their city.
- Pray that God would give leaders in our cities guidance and understanding and help them fear God rather than man.
- Pray that God would call out a new generation into ministry and service of God's kingdom; giving them faith, courage, and initiative to obey His call. Pray that God would provide prayer, encouragement, and resources to undergird their work spiritually and financially.
- Pray that God would help new believers learn to abide in Christ, be filled with His Spirit, and living according to the will of Christ
- Pray that believers will love the Lord with all their heart, mind, soul, and strength. That they would walk in love, kindness, and favor with the lost and believers around them.
- Pray that God would convict lost family and friends of sin, God's coming judgment, and their need for the Savior.
- Pray that God would grant the lost a repentant heart that turns fully to Christ.
- Pray that God would save the lost, change their hearts, and fill them with God's Spirit.

- Pray that governmental authorities would not be distracted or cower into passivity but embrace responsibility. That they would watch over, protect, lead, and serve those in their care.
- Pray that pastors would abide in Christ and be devoted to prayer, relying on God.
- Pray that pastors would rightly divide the Word of truth and communicate the gospel with clarity.
- Pray that your children(all children) would receive wisdom, understanding, knowledge and discretion from the Lord.
- Pray for your children/grandchildren to have respect and submit to those in authority. To be surrounded by the right kinds of friends and avoid wrong friendships.
- Pray for your spouse; to be surrounded with wise friends and use good judgment, pursue justice, love mercy and walk humbly with God. That they would depend upon God’s wisdom and strength rather than his/her own.
- Pray for SPIRITUAL AWAKENING IN AMERICA!
- For plans and preparations for Congress Of Nations in 2023.
- We are joining the ministry of *Revive Our Hearts* to “Cry Out” to our King with other believers intervening on behalf of our broken world. Cry out to God
- Pray that our churches would sense the urgency of these times – that every moment of these days of grace draws us ever closer to the moment of Jesus’ return.
