Weekly Prayer Requests for Week 18: November 6 – November 12, 2022

ADORATION: praising God for who He is and what He has done.

You, O Lord, have declared; “My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways. As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts.” You are the Lord, the God of all humankind. Nothing is too difficult for You. I know that You save Your anointed O Lord; You answer from Your holy heaven with the saving strength of Your right hand. Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but I will trust in Your name, O Lord my God. May all Your saints love You, O Lord! You preserve the faithful and fully repay the proud. We will be of good courage for You will strengthen the hearts of those who hope in You.

Pause to express your thoughts of praise and worship.

CONFESSION: stating our sins and asking forgiveness!

Father God, heal us from our sin. Deliver us for the sake of your steadfast love. Our sins are troubling to us and are offensive to You. Our sins are heavy to carry, too real to hide, and too deep to undo. Forgive what our lips speak that is unkind, unholy, impure. Forgive our hearts of stone. Replace the stony hearts with hearts that are pure and holy before You. Set us free from a past that we cannot change; open to us a future in which we can be changed by Your refining fire; and grant us grace to grow more and more in your likeness and image, through Jesus Christ, the light of the world.

Ask the Spirit to search your heart and reveal any areas of unconfessed sin. Acknowledge these to the Lord and thank Him for His forgiveness.

THANKSGIVING: thanking God for specific things that He has done.

Heavenly Father, as we enter a season of Thanksgiving, may our hearts be drawn to the ultimate prayer of thanks to You for Your gift of eternal life. As we bow our heads and hearts to You and pray, thanking You for all You've done, we're especially thankful for the gift of Jesus, Your Son. For the beauty of the earth, Your glory, for joy and health, friends and family, we are

a blessed people. We praise you for Your great love and all Your wonderful deeds to us. We sing joyfully about Your glorious acts. We thank You for Your great wisdom. Daniel prayed a prayer of thanks to You for the wisdom and insight for the king's dream. Thank you for enlightening our minds to truth and to the understanding of Your word. We thank you for who You are. The prophet Jeremiah recalled Your goodness in spite of great destruction in Jerusalem. God, You are with us, always. You are with us when times are great and You are with us in times of worry, anxiety, sadness, distress. You are Immanuel, God with us in the past, in the future and right here where we are. We praise You and Bless Your name, O Most High!

Pause to offer your own expressions of thanksgiving. In prayer this week, thank God for His provision in your life.

SUPPLICATION: asking God for our needs and our wants.

Hear our cry, O God, and listen to our prayer.

From the ends of the earth, we call to You when our hearts grow faint;

Lead us to the rock that is higher than we are.

You have been a shelter for us

And a strong tower against the enemy.

We will dwell in Your tent forever

And take refuge in the shelter of Your wings.

We want to know You, O Christ, and the power of Your resurrection and the fellowship of Your sufferings, being conformed to Your death, that we may attain to the resurrection from the dead.

- Continue to lift up victims of Hurricane Ian. Pray for those that have lost friends and family members and pray for the rapid response teams that are the ground. Pray for open doors-safety and protection- for relief teams like the Billy Graham Rapid Response Teams and other faith-based teams to share the Gospel message and that many will come to faith in Jesus Christ. Our own John Schweizer (IFW) Washington State will be on site this week serving with Calvary Everett from Washington.
- Pray that God would break any bondage, stronghold, or addiction in the lives of believers. Pray that believers would walk in integrity, keeping their promises, and fulfilling their commitments. Pray that they would share the gospel faithfully and make disciples of others in their lives.
- Pray that God would unite local pastors in prayer for one another and for revival and restoration in their city. Pray that pastors would exhibit love, comfort, and encouragement as he performs weddings, funerals, and counseling. Pray that he would emulate the grace, strength, and compassion of the Good Shepherd toward all those he leads.
- Pray that God would pour out His Spirit and bring revival to the church and spiritual awakening to our cities. Pray that corrupt laws and standards would be replaced with just and godly ones.
- Pray that God would call out a new generation into ministry and service of God's kingdom; giving them faith, courage, and initiative to obey His call. Pray that God would provide prayer, encouragement, and resources to undergird their work spiritually and financially.
- Pray that God would help new believers learn to abide in Christ, be filled with His Spirit, and live according to the will of Christ
- Pray that believers will love the Lord with all their heart, mind, soul, and strength. That they would walk in love, kindness, and favor with the lost and believers around them.
